WISE FILTER PLANT 3rd FILTER VESSEL PROJECT WITH ECCV: Chris Muller provided information on the third filter vessel project with ECCV. Work would include adding a third filter vessel and converting the LAS storage to a tank instead of a tote. The total preliminary cost is \$1,400,000. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Board approved the WISE Filter Vessel Project with ECCV.

DISCUSSIONS

BINNEY CONNECTION: Kate Bandel presented an update on the Binney Connection Project. The contractor has completed working on Alexander Road. Pictures were shown of the progress of the projects.

WATER DELIVERIES AND OPERATIONS: Kate Bandel explained that WISE has been receiving the full 2 MGD from the City of Aurora. Kate also noted that the Stonegate Meter was replaced.

During the months of August, September and October WISE will be increasing sampling of the University Tank Pipeline and Smoky Hill Tank. Lower operating level will be targeted in the Smoky Hill Tank.

A monthly update memo was provided with the Board materials.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business to come before the Board and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned at 1:25 p.m. The next WISE board meeting is scheduled for September 21st, 2022.
