**South Metro Water Supply Authority Reelects Charlie Krogh
as Board President for the Third Year Running**

Greenwood Village, Colo. – March 24, 2009 – South Metro Water Supply Authority (SMWSA), a public entity consisting of 13 cooperating water providers in Douglas and Arapahoe Counties, reelected Charlie Krogh as its board president for the third consecutive year in a unanimous vote last month.

Krogh is the district manager for Pinery Water and Wastewater District and the Special District Association's 2008 Manager of the Year. Krogh has nearly 30 years of water-planning and engineering experience and also serves on the board of the Cherry Creek Basin Water Quality Authority, the Havana Water and Sanitation District, the Douglas County Water Resource Authority and the Cherry Creek Project Water Authority.

These nine water providers include: Arapahoe County Water and Wastewater Authority, Castle Pines North Metropolitan District, Cottonwood Water and Sanitation District, Inverness Water and Sanitation District, Meridian Metropolitan District, Pinery Water and Wastewater District, Roxborough Park Metropolitan District, Stonegate Village Metropolitan District and the Castle Pines Metropolitan District.
